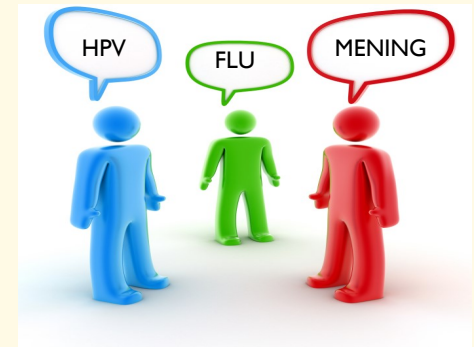

Vaccines are widely available; however, every year in the United States, approximately 42,000 adult and 300 child deaths are due to vaccine-preventable diseases. Barriers affecting rates and making our society more vulnerable to the diseases they prevent include lack of knowledge, cost, fear of pain, poor record-keeping, time/ transportation issues and recent anti-vaccine messages. All of these barriers serve to make Mid America Immunization Coalition's promotion of immunizations among the entire population of the metro area even more
